Please be informed that the Board of Regents, at its 1272nd meeting on 25 August 2011, approved the revision of the International Publication Award.

Among others, the revisions of the IPA are the following:

1. All faculty members and REPS of UP who are authors of an international peer-reviewed (Thomson Reuters, SCI-indexed) publication will receive a pro-rated share of the IPA. Project researchers and thesis students who work on UP projects, and indicate UP as their affiliation in the publication, will also receive a pro-rated share of the IPA.

Each UP author will receive a pro-rated share of the IPA equal to P55,000 divided by the total number of authors.

2. A UP unit (department, institute, center, etc.) indicated as the affiliate institution of authors in an international publication, will receive an IPA apart from the IPA for authors. The IPA per publication for UP units is P15,000.

Each UP affiliate unit will receive a pro-rated share of the IPA equal to P15,000 multiplied by the number of authors affiliated with the UP unit divided by the total number of authors.
